# **ARTS & CULTURE IN THE SQUARE**

CALL FOR PARTICIPATION FOR ARTISTS

**DUE MARCH 29, 4:30 PM** 





#### **WHAT**

Cleveland's new Public Square is full of possibilities – and this summer, you can bring creative and imaginative programming to this vibrant space. With funding from <u>National Endowment for the Arts</u> and <u>Group Plan Commission</u> and in partnership with <u>LAND studio</u>, Cuyahoga Arts & Culture will provide up to \$5,000 for artists to carry out projects.

Our goal is to bring a diverse range of free, fresh and new programming to Public Square this summer. Projects can be recurring, and can span across all arts and cultural disciplines. Some ideas include:

- star gazing on the square
- teaching kids about animals
- science experiments and demonstrations
- musical, dance or theatrical performances
- dance class for the public
- creating a communal painting
- storytelling
- planting a mobile community garden

#### WHO

Artists/makers living in Cuyahoga County can submit project ideas. Selected artists will work with Group Plan Commission for technical assistance and project management.

#### **HOW**

Interested artists should submit their project ideas at <u>cacgrants.org/square</u> by **Wednesday, March 29 at 4:30 pm**. A committee of local residents will review submissions. 2/3 of your review will be based on your project's ability to "enliven the space" and the remaining 1/3 based on your "project's feasibility." We define these criteria as:

#### Enliven the space:

- create a program that brings dozens to Public Square
- create fresh programming that inspires the community to engage creatively and/or differently
- contribute to a lively and energetic Public Square

#### Project's feasibility:

- create a project that is realistic
- demonstrate a clear plan to execute the project
- engage qualified and diverse professionals for the project

Priority will be given to projects that allow for a broad range of disciplines. Based on these recommendations, CAC will select the top projects and notify artists by April 14.

#### WHEN

March 29 at 4:30 pm: Deadline to submit project ideas at cacgrants.org/square

April 11: Review committee meets to review and score submissions

April 14: CAC notifies selected organizations

May 1 - August 31: Projects take place

**FAQS** 

#### Can an individual submit a project idea?

Yes, individual artists/makers are able to apply for this opportunity. Visit <u>cacgrants.org/square</u> for more information.

### How much total funding is available?

\$100,000 will be available in total for 5-15 projects. Of that, \$80,000 will be available to organizations and \$20,000 to artists.

#### What is the maximum amount I can request?

Individual artists can request up to \$5,000.

# What do you mean by an artist/maker?

An artist/maker is any individual practicing arts and culture. Our definition for arts and culture is based on the Ohio Revised Code, which governs our work at CAC. According to the Code, arts and culture includes, but is not limited to, performance, literature, visual arts, architecture, science, history and natural history.

# Who will make decisions about funding?

A committee will meet to review all submissions. 2/3 of your review will be based on your project's ability to "enliven the space" and the remaining 1/3 based on your "project's feasibility." We define these criteria as:

#### Enliven the space:

- create a program that brings dozens to Public Square
- create fresh programming that inspires the community to engage creatively and/or differently
- contribute to a lively and energetic Public Square

# Project's feasibility:

- create a project that is realistic
- demonstrate a clear plan to execute the project
- engage qualified and diverse professionals for the project

# Is there a matching requirement for this funding?

No, there is no matching requirement.

# Can I submit more than one project idea?

No, each artist can only submit one project idea.

# Who will help me with logistical assistance if my project is selected?

Group Plan Commission will assist selected artists with any logistical needs, including securing rental equipment. The pricing for these rentals are as follows; use them as a guide in developing your budget:

Quicken Loans Permanent Stage: No Charge

Rental Stage: \$450.00 (flat fee) (Standard Size - 24' x 16' x 32")
 Sound Equipment: \$800.00 (flat Fee) (Includes 1 Mic, Stand & Cable)

Additional Mic, Stand & Cable Pkg.: \$125.00 eachAudio Tech: \$385.00 (flat fee)

Lighting Fixtures: \$60.00 each (PAR 56 Fixtures)

Stage Labor: \$22.50 per hour
 Equipment Trucking/Delivery: \$135 (flat fee)
