Purpose	Grants provide support for arts or cultural projects occurring in Cuyahoga County within the 2017 calendar year. Past recipients have included arts and culture organizations, community development corporations, social service agencies and a variety of other 501c3 organizations providing arts and cultural programming.

Match Component	1:1 cash match required. For every CAC dollar you receive, you must raise at least one dollar from another source.	1:1 match required, of which 25% can be met through in-kind support.
Reporting Requirements	1 online final report during 1-year grant period (due within 60 days of the project end)
