Mission: to leverage vibrant arts and culture to foster economic growth in Gordon Square.

**Vision**: an exciting Gordon Square Arts District with vibrant theatres and enhanced art activity that is a regional destination for arts and culture.

## GSAD Goals:

- 1. Create sustainable prosperity through arts and culture initiatives
- 2. Build on the arts identity through enhanced placemaking, arts programming and community-wide marketing
- 3. Engage and support artists and creative professionals who live and work in the neighborhood and provide tools for economic self-sufficiency
- 4. Protect and expand on the physical and institutional assets of the arts district

Job Description Arts Programming Associate Part-time, freelance or experienced Intern

The Gordon Square Arts District is seeking a **part-time, freelance Arts Programming Associate or Intern** to assist with building new arts programs from **late-April through August**, with a possible extension. Primary duties will include event coordination, artist outreach, and database development.

GSAD adopted a new strategic and tactical plan in 2016 that draws from the neighborhood's master plan recommendations and enhances it with new ideas that align the arts with economic opportunities. New programs launching in 2017 include an artist network, outdoor arts performances, a micro-art gallery space for local artists, the infusion of vibrant public art and murals in blighted spaces, a new wayfinding program, an artist residency, and support for small businesses and galleries.

## Primary programs that need support from the Arts Programming Associate or Intern:

## Gordon Square Artist Network

We are building a network of artists living and/or working in GSAD in order to develop tools to better align the arts with economic opportunities. We'll develop a database of artists and other creative professionals and their mediums. We'll hold mixers at a local establishment and include artist presentations of work in progress and/or speakers (like a salon). We will engage the artists

in a discussion forum about artistic content of the neighborhood and incorporate their input. *Primary work will include artist outreach and the development of a database.* 

## Gordon Square Outdoor Arts Programming

With support from Cuyahoga Arts & Culture, GSAD will host six free outdoor performances in Near West Plaza between June-August 2017. Artistic performances such as music and theatre will be tailored to reach the diverse segments of the neighborhood population, from a popular Latin band to Italian opera, to increase the inclusion of all residents and attract visitors. The events will be paired with local food businesses and retail merchants in order to enhance economic opportunities associated with the new series. Neighborhood-based nonprofit community partners will also be included. As a pilot project, we will experiment with scheduling different days of the week and times and evaluate which audiences each attract as well as measure any positive economic impact on local businesses. *Primary work will include event coordination and working with the performers.* 

# <u>Other duties as assigned</u>: assist with installation of art in the micro-art gallery, optional Saturday gallery shifts, assist with wayfinding inventory

## Skills required:
