Plante Moran specializes in audit, tax, consulting, and wealth management services, and will be ready to answer your questions. This workshop is both for organizations that already complete the 990 or 990-EZ, or those that currently complete the 990-N but are curious about switching.

Note: A 990 or 990-EZ is required for any CAC grants over \$5,000 and Cultural Heritage applicants, and is a useful tool to add transparency to your organization's finances.

This webinar will cover the basics of completing your Cultural Data Profile (CDP) on the SMU DataArts platform. We will also go over changes made to the CDP in December 2020 to better track your activities through the COVID-19 pandemic, share free tools to analyze your data, and discuss examples of recent research enabled by CDP data. This session is ideal for new users, or anyone looking for a refresher about how to enter your data and create a Funder Report for a grant deadline.

Note: The CDP is required for Cultural Heritage applications and any Project Support application over \$5,000.
