## Cuyahoga Arts and Culture (CAC) Announces 2009 Project Support Grants Trustees Approve Fifty-Five Awards

The Board of Trustees of Cuyahoga Arts and Culture (CAC) has approved fifty-five awards totaling \$825,695 for the 2009 cycle of its annual Project Support (PS) Grant program. The awards, which will support projects in locations throughout Cuyahoga County, range in value from \$1,000 to \$50,000. They were announced today during a meeting of the CAC board. To date, CAC has approved grants totaling \$17.3 million this year bringing the total of approved funding to more than \$33.5 million since CAC's inception in April 2007.

2009 Project Support grantees represent the program's second cycle and follow its inaugural (2008) class of awards, which went to fifty-four organizations. 2009 grantees—all of which received the full amount of their grant request from CAC—were selected from among sixty-three eligible applications scored during a two-day public panel review held April 29-30, 2009 at the Idea Center at Playhouse Square in Cleveland. Panelists included eight arts and cultural professionals from outside Ohio.

"We have been able to extend the reach of CAC by making grants to twenty-five organizations that will receive Project Support funds for the first time," said Meg Harris, CAC interim executive director. "These twenty-five along with our thirty "repeat" grantees exemplify the exceptional diversity of this county's arts and cultural sector and its vital presence in so many communities." Ms. Harris continued, "The creativity of the 2009 projects and the competence of those who will carry them out assure us that CAC's investment will hold meaning not only for audiences and participants who are directly involved, but also for those touched by the valuable economic impacts they will generate for Cuyahoga County's cultural tourism industry."

Descriptions of selected projects as well as a complete listing of 2009 PS grants follow this release.

In other recent CAC news, the CAC Board of Trustees has selected trustee Christopher M. Coburn to fill the office of Vice President, replacing Santina Protopapa whose tenure on the CAC board ended on March 31, 2009. Steven A. Minter and David Bergholz will continue in their respective roles as board president and secretary.

Rounding out the five-member board are Vickie Eaton Johnson, executive director of Fairfax Renaissance Development Corporation and Sari Feldman, the executive director of the Cuyahoga County Public Library. Both were appointed to three-year terms effective April 1, 2009.

Cuyahoga Arts and Culture makes grants using public funds to support Cuyahoga County's arts and cultural sector and the valuable contribution arts and culture makes to children's learning experiences as well as to the county's appeal and economic vitality. CAC revenues are generated by a levy approved by Cuyahoga County voters in November 2006. Meetings of the CAC's five-member Board of Trustees are regularly held the second Tuesday of each month and are open to the public.

## 2009 CAC Project Support Grants Selected Awards

Among the outstanding organizations and projects approved for funding during the April 2009 review of CAC Project Support grant applications are (a complete listing follows this page):

- African Soul International, which will provide cultural arts workshops and performances for youth, while focusing on character development and community service. (Award amount: \$17,375)
- Berea Arts Fest, which will include demonstrating artists at this year's Arts Fest in order to engage the public in the creation of art from an artist's point of view.
   Attendees will observe the artists at work and will witness the creative and technical processes involved in the creation of artwork. (Award amount: \$1,000)
- CityMusic Cleveland, which will present a new work commissioned by Christos Hatzis, performed in four venues by CityMusic and the Pacifica Quartet led by conductor David Alan Miller. This new work will incorporate a SurroundSound component to be created in collaboration with Bugsy H, a Detroit Rap artist. (Award amount: \$50,000)
- Duffy Liturgical Dance Ensemble, which will produce a major concert including community workshops and dialogues devoted to the enduring Legacy of the Spiritual Art Form. The performance will embrace the lessons learned from two faces of The Spiritual, sacred and secular. (Award amount: \$17,700)
- Morgan Art of Papermaking Conservatory and Educational Foundation, which will sponsor a papermaking workshop for military veterans with visiting artists Combat Paper, nationally known artists from Vermont. (Award amount: \$2,400)
- Ohio Boychoir, which, in collaboration with the Cleveland BoyChoir, will perform Coming Together- A Collaborative Concert Series. This joint project will strengthen the artistic value of the organizations, while creating an opportunity for cultural sharing among the artistic staffs, audiences, and memberships of the groups. (Award amount: \$10,000)
