**Your Project Title:** Family Film & Culture Nights

**Your Project Summary:** The Friday Film & Culture Nights are an arts and film series that take place throughout the summer at West Park's Impett Park. The goal of the series is to build community by both highlighting and celebrating the spectrum of cultures, languages, and arts in West Park through fun and engaging music, art, dance, and film that brings the community together.

**Final Score: Yes.** Overall, the panel felt that the applicant provided evidence throughout the application that the funding criteria were met.

**CAC Grant Amount: \$4,500**

To ensure an impartial and transparent application review process, CAC convened an online panel of arts and cultural professionals from outside the region who evaluated and scored eligible applications.
